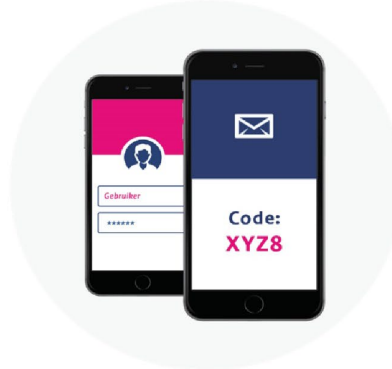
# The Dutch Trust Framework
